Core Food Support

The Oilfields Food Bank provides core food support service to clients in need with perishable and non-perishable food items, without a financial cost or any commitment requirement such as, volunteer participation, donation obligation, engagement in faith-based activities.

Full food assistance is provided to those residing in the Diamond Valley, Longview, Millarville, Priddis, and surrounding area who are willing and able to provide identification and proof of residency.

The Intake Coordinator may, at their discretion, provide full food assistance to anyone unable or unwilling to provide identification and proof of community residency.

The Oilfields Food Bank is committed to a non-discriminatory approach in providing food assistance, preserving the dignity and respect of those served. No individual shall be denied access to food on the basis of race, ethnicity, gender, religion, age, disability, sexual orientation, or any other protected characteristic.
